The project will be subject to the NT Work Health and Safety (National Uniform Legislation) Act 2011 and Regulations and as such Hazardous Chemicals and high risks will need to be catered for by the Operator during their mining activities. There may also be some licensing requirements and notification requirements under this legislation.

The Operator should be aware of their legislative duties with respect to this legislation and are required to submit a Risk Management Plan addressing the hazards and controls they intend to put in place.

NT WorkSafe will liaise with the Operator over these matters.
