Description of proposed action	To develop a weather-resistant ferry berthing facility at Mandorah (within Lots 116 and 50, Hundred of Bray), to improve transport connectivity between the Cox Peninsula and Darwin. The proposal area would cover six hectares comprising: • northern and southern rock armoured breakwaters • dredging of an access channel, turning basin and berthing areas • a new single lane boat ramp and car park modification • floating pontoon, gangway, jetty and rock armoured access causeway • a ferry terminal building.
