**Subject:** NTPFES - Comment – Draft EIS - Primary Gold - Rustlers Roost and Quest 29 Open-Cut Mine Redevelopment

Good Morning.

The Northern Territory (NT) Police Fire and Emergency Services (NTPFES) has the following comments to provide:

- The remote location of the operation is outside the NT Fire, Rescue Services (NTFRS) Emergency Response Area (ERA), which limits the ability to respond to an emergency in a timely manner;
- With regards to road crash/response, the NTFRS crews will respond as required within existing capacity as with any other crash. If the timeliness of that response does not adequately mitigate the risk for Primary Gold then self-funded measures should be implemented;
- The NTFRS is happy to advise Primary Gold on current capabilities in the vicinity of their operations to inform their risk assessment; and
- The NTPFES are not in a position to provide comment around environmental impacts within this request for comment.
